We have over 1200 users so our upgrade plans for Office 2007 are not in the near future since the user experience will change quite extensively, we will need to train the userbase first. However, we will be upgrading to WSS v3 so hopefully we wont run into that issue.

"JonathanD" wrote:

We actually upgraded our WSS 2.0 to SP3 and that caused the issue on the client machines running Office 2K3. Since we only have a few people that use the functionality I decided to attempt some client-based fixes. Last night we found that if you upgrade to Office 2K7 the issue is no longer there. So as our temporary fix, this is our solution ...

I wonder if anyone out there has installed Office 2k3 SP3 and is not experiencing the datasheet lockout. We do not have that problem but we have not installed SP3 yet either (and I do not think we will....yet). Can you use system restore to back out of the SP3 on a machine to see if that restores the datasheet functionality?
