Since you did not supply the database you are using I will supply an example using dynamic SQL. I also included only the first three fields. I assume that the three fields are string data. The strings are surrounded by apostrophes. You would omit the apostrophes for numeric data. Date handling is database dependent. So here it is:

```
strSql = "INSERT INTO forest " & _  
        "(fld1, fld2, fld3) " & _  
        "VALUES('" & UCase(SLNO) & "', '" & UCase(empcode) & "', '" & UCase(Name) & "')
```

```
FCON.Execute strSql, , adExecuteNoRecords
```

You get the picture. You can now replace fld1-fld3 with the correct field names and add the remaining fields to the SQL statement.

I hope this helps.
