Hi Boaz,

I am sorry if I did not make clarification about the problem.

When we use a disconnected recordset, i.e. we do not use the databinding. After we update the change from the flexgrid to the recordset, the change will not be update into the database unless we explicitly call the recordset's update or updatebatch method.

And from your description, you want to make a few steps in database side when you insert or delete a row.

Since this is somewhat complicated to be implemented in client side, so I want to know what database are you using.

For SQL server we can use the Trigger, which is a special kind of stored procedure that executes automatically when a user attempts the specified data-modification statement on the specified table. Microsoft? SQL Server? allows the creation of multiple triggers for any given INSERT, UPDATE, or DELETE statement.
