Hi,

I try to create a COM Component on my local machine (W2K) and get a "Runtime Error 70, Permission Denied" Error.

```
dim o as myComponent
set o = new myComponent '<===== permission denied
```

myComponent is a self developed C++ COM Component. The constructor contains no code at all.

The error occurs only if I log on as "Domain User". With local administrator privileges everthing works fine, but I can't give admin permissions to all users.

And now the interesting thing. Bevor I installed the Microsoft SNA Client the component worked with "Domain User" privileges. Reinstalling the latest W2K Service Pack changes nothing. And something else. VB COM Components are still createable and callable.
