Yes, you are correct. However, in this case each line item is assigned an employeeId who receives credit (commission) for the item. So it is possible that two different employees receive credit for one or more of the same item. So I am still stuck trying to store the quantity of each item.

Or, you might make a similar distinct list for the credit. Even if you want to keep separate line items, such a distinct list would still be useful.
