Although Mark Alexander Bertenshaw seems to have found his solution, I haven't found mine yet. My problem is the following:

This is the code I use:

I want to zip the files in the folder "D:\Visual

Basic\MyDB\MyDBFolder". This code does that but it adds the full folder structure to the zip file:

Visual Basic---->MyDB---->MyDBFolder---->Subfolders....

However, I only want to zip the files and subfolders in "MyDBFolder":

MyDBFolder---->Subfolders...

No matter what I try, I simply can't get the program to do what I want.
