The width of the form is set to be exactly the width of the picture in the Image control.

The actual Width property of a form includes the borders, so the client area (as described by ScaleHeight and ScaleWidth) will always be smaller than the Width of the form unless the form is borderless. Did you actually mean what you literally said?

For example, let's talk pixels and a graphic that's 500 x whatever. The normal Windows theme has a 4-pixel border, so if your form is 500 pixels wide then your client area is 492 pixels wide. You'd need to bump the overall width to 508 in order to display an image that's 500 pixels wide.
