My application (non-MFC/ATL) does include some calls to ATL (e.g. AtlAxWinInit() and AtlAxGetControl()) and I'm also having trouble making it link statically so I can avoid the atl71.dll dependency.

I selected "Use of ATL" = "Static link to ATL" but I don't see the `_ATL_DLL` or `_ATL_STATIC_REGISTRY` mentioned in the original post.

These macros should be taken care of for you when you change the project setting. I'm not sure why the OP had to manipulate .vcproj file by hand – there are indications that he or she simply didn't apply the change to all configurations.
