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I moved the entire solution to a XP machine (32 bit) that has VS2008 and it compiles clean.

The other thing that I thought was interesting. I added a file copy to the project of the CPP DLL (post build) to copy the dll to another location and then changed the test exe to get the reference from that location, and I got the same results. This makes no sense to me at all!

I found that we had a hotfix for this issue internally, however I have not found a published KB article for clarification. I am trying to contact the related developer to confirm this and will update you later. Sorry for bringing you any inconvenience.

In addition, from your description, it seemed that this issue did not occur before but that it raised until a recent Windows update, right? Could you please also confirm with me whether you can reproduce this issue on other machine?
