If you want to compile by the command line for VS2005, under the start menu at "Visual Studio 2005->Visual Studio tools->" Select "Visual Studio 2005 Command prompt" that will give you access to "nmake" which will compile via the command line.

Technically, nmake will execute makefiles. If you've built a makefile that invoke cl.exe – the command line compiler, then it will help you compile via the command line.

From the command line, there's also VCBuild.exe, which will build an VC++

IDE project from the command line.
