microsoft.public.windows.vista.installation_setup

I can't tell you how to get to it using your browser. However, you can access it within Outlook Express as follows:

Click on

Tools->Accounts

then click on the Add button and select News.

Follow the prompts in the wizard and enter

Re: Windows vista

msnews.microsoft.com

as the news server.

At the completion of the wizard, you will be prompted to download a list of newsgroups. Do this, then find

microsoft.public.windows.vista.installation_setup

in the list.
