According to the MSDN website, with my MSDN Universal subscription, one benefit is:

"Managed newsgroups are for current MSDN Universal, Enterprise, Professional or Operating System subscribers. These subscribers can post a message and receive a response from Microsoft Support Professionals within 2 business days"

Typically, I post with the google groups interface (groups.google.com) and so far I haven't had any more or less success in getting responses than with the MS group reader in MSDN. So, is there any difference in posting using my MSDN account versus posting with just a regular ol' NNTP reader?
