I'm working in a flow in Visio 2003 that is 320" x 34" (printed to a plotter) and I can not zoom to over 107%. I have tried the view toolbar and the View – Zoom – <Percentage> menu as well as the Ctrl + Scroll Wheel methods to try and increase the view size. I'm not sure when the problem started but know that at one point, I could zoom to +200% in this cocument. Zoom/Magnify works fine in other documents.
