

# Re: Windows Search 4.0 update crashes Search function

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Last week, I migrated my data and applications from my administrator account (that I had been using on a daily basis for all tasks) to a new standard user account, thinking that my administrator account that I had been using for almost a year had some corrupt system files.

I now have my Vista user accounts set up like this:

- one administrator account that I only use for computer maintenance tasks.
- one standard account that I use on a daily basis.

The Search function is working fine now.

I've been running my Vista for almost a year and, overall, my Vista is running fast and smooth. No other problems right now (except for the 1 or 2 times a month that Windows Explorer crashes for 2-3 seconds when I'm using some old software.)

If it's any cold comfort, I installed the Windows Search 4.0 update tonight on my Dell M1330 with Vista and had the same problem. The system restarted with tons of errors; re-booted and then I got the Blue Screen of Death and had to do a system repair (multiple steps) to get back to the last good boot. Definitely something about this update causes corruption.
