The most likely explanation is that the recipient has something mis-configured on their end. However, you should double-check your

settings:

Make sure the image you are attaching is not open in another program.

Make sure attachments are enabled:
Tools, Safety Options, Security, uncheck "Block images..." and also uncheck "Do not allow attachments..."

Also go to Tools, Options, Send, Mail Sending Format, HTML Settings, make sure "Send pictures with messages" is checked.

Re: No graphics???

The next time you send an email with graphics, put your own email address

on the BCC line. When you receive that email, you can verify that the graphics

are indeed in the sent email.
