I have an HP Media Vault. I can access public folders that do not have password security. I cannot access public folders that have password security or private folders. I am the administrator. I have set up the passwords and logins. When I attempt to access a private folder or a public folder that has a password, I get the following message:

SERVER\FOLDER is not accessible. You might not have permission to use this network resource. Contact the administrator of this server to find out if you have access permissions. Multiple connections to a server or shared resource by the same user, using more than one user name, are not allowed. Disconnect all previous connections to the server or shared resource and try again.
