

cannot debug VB6 DLL

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I create a VB6 DLL object within an ASP.NET page. I've set a reference to it in my project and call with (in C#)

```
this.vbObject = new VB6Proj.VB6Class();
```

Normally this works fine at runtime. And it usually works fine when I start up VB6 first, run the project, set a breakpoint, and bring up the webpage. But now, when debugging in VB6, I get Server Error

Access is denied.
