After importing a project solution into a VS2005.Beta2, build errors abound. The errors are all:

The name 'xxxx' does not exist in the current context.

Well, when VS2005 imported (and converted) the project, it created an App\_Code folder. Then it put all the .cs files in the App\_Code folder separating them from their associated .aspx/.resx files.

Fine, I'm all for separating the code–behinds, but if it does that, then it should also change whatever it needs to change to tell the .cs files where these declarations now are being made.

How do I fix this? Where is this setting?
