I've created a new Windows Forms Project in Visual Studio 2008 targeting the 2.0 framework (this is going to be running on Windows 2000 machines).

I've added a setup project to the solution and under project properties | prerequisites I've ensured that only Windows Installer 3.1 and .Net framework 2.0 are ticked.

However, when a user tries to run the msi they are given the message "This setup requires the .Net framework version 3.5. Please install the .Net Framework and run this setup again."

Any ideas what I'm doing wrong or how to fix this?
