As suggested in a different posted, I extracted all the files to a network drive using ISO Buster and tried the installation. This time also the installation failed !

The error message was "The installer encountered an unexpected error installing the package. The error code is 2337".

Is there anything else I can do other than re-downloading the package ?

- > *I downloaded the .iso file of "VS 2005 Beta1 Refresh with Team System" from*
- > *MSDN. I am trying to install this on Win XP SP1 running on Virtual PC 2004.*
- > *Since I don't have a DVD burner, I mounted the .iso image as a virtual drive*
- > *(using Virtual CD control panel utility) and ran the installation. I am*
- > *running the installation from admin account, disabled Norton Anti-Virus &*
- > *Internet Security and, while installing VS 2005, I get this error :*
- > *"ERROR:Error 1311.Source file not found: z:\vs_13124_SdmModels.msm.cab.*
- > *Verify that the file exists and that it is accessible".*
- >
- > *The file "_13124_SdmModels.msm.cab" does exist and I am able to view the cab*
- > *file's contents from explorer. So, I don't understand why this should happen.*
- > *Is it that VS 2005 can only be installed from a DVD/CD and not from a virtual*
- > *drive ?*
