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Hi Jason,

I am having to use IP address due to a problem click once has when I use the DNS name of the installation server verses the NetBIOS name. The IP Address was a work around for XP. I'm thinking the IP is making Vista think this is an external address??

yes, I think the problem is the above workaround only works in Windows XP, but it needs the privilege elevation under Vista and the ClickOnce just forbids the elevation.

I suggest you may need to tune your approach to prevent it requiring a privilege elevation under Vista.

By the way, you also could try to run your VS2005 elevated Run as Administrator') when you want to publish your ClickOnce application on Vista.
