> problem with the first domain controller; the problem
> exists in the second domain controller. I decided to make
> the second DC as a member server by using the command
> dcpromo and then I can make it again as a DC, during the
> process of removing the active directory from the server
> using dcpromo I got this message:
> "The operation failed because: Managging the network with
> gasco-server.gasco.al-amerya failed "login failure: The
> target account name is incorrect"
> And I got another one:
> "Naming information cannot be located because: the target
> principal name in incorrect"
