We have a Windows 2000 Active Directory with 3 DCs.

A while back the DCs were replaced, all of the FSMOs were moved to the new DCs and the 2 DCs were removed.

In the event logs we get an Event ID 1010 "Automatic enrollment against the certification authority "MY\_DOMAIN\_NAME" for a certificate of type DomainController has failed. "

I assuming that the Certificate for our domain was not moved before the DCs were taken offline. Is this something that needs to be addressed?

Can we create a new one without any impact to our Active Directory?
