Hey All.

the server was originally a windows 2000 sp4 DC. i upgraded to windows 2003 SP1, which worked fine but once i upgraded to R2, the machine is not allowing any incoming connections (icmp) I get tons of error messages related to services that normally would require connectivity.

I've tried disabled ICF, enabling it and allowing for ICMP – nothing i'm disabled any ipsec polices and added the ProhibitIpSec registry key i've reinstalled the NIC drivers about 4 times.

i can't figure it out, it appears that its letting selective traffic pass through it but definitely not ICMP.
