To disable outbound replication for a particular DC, use the following command:

```
repadmin /options <dc name> +DISABLE_OUTBOUND_REPL
```

To re-enable outbound replication, run:

```
repadmin /options <dc name> -DISABLE_OUTBOUND_REPL
```

To disable inbound replication for a particular DC, use the following command:

```
repadmin /options <dc name> +DISABLE_INBOUND_REPL
```
