this is how the production boxes are set-up here and i have noticed a difference between the two databases by about 200 records. i finally found (it took a long time, though) an MS KB that says you should point the WINS server to itself only and no secondaries should be listed. otherwise, you could see a disjointed database, which is what i suspect i have. i made the changes today and will post back after a couple days and let everyone know how it turns out.
