Very well could be. However, to really know for sure, would need to do specific testing in your environment and name usage patterns and cache loading, forwarder loading, etc. If you have, for example, a domain name NS that is already cached, then the resolver will find that NS as the closest NS and query it directly with one query and one reply. In most cases, com, net, org will already be cached so unknown second level domain will require 2 queries. For the most part, either method or both seems to work well in most cases. Cheers.
