I noticed the modem test failure as well. Which is interesting because I dont have a modem on any server on our network. But I will have to look into that as it may be something I am not thinking of.

lha4ucsd2 does the job of domain controller as well as ISA Server 2000. We have a Smart Filter Plug-in that is installed on it as well. We use it to block outside websites based on content and such. We also cache a few sites but not many. The network configuration for ISA is pretty much default for the most part. We have the routing configured in as well as the LAT & LDT.

dcdiag /e for the most part passes on both DC's. The MachineAccount test fails but this is because we have it in a different OU called COMPOSE Domain Controllers. SPAWAR installed this network last year in July and had the OU setup like this. I imagine this test has failed for quite some time. Services test failed as well but only because we have three services disabled. TrkWks, TrkSvr, and SMTPSVC services are the ones disabled. We have those disabled since we dont
