

## Concurrent outgoing faxes

Hi,

I'm using Windows 2003 fax with 4 fax devices configured for send/receive. Well it is working fine, I'm submitting fax from the same machine by printing to the local fax printer.

The problem is the following:

- 1) I submitted a 6 pages fax. Microsoft Fax starts to send the fax
- 2) Meanwhile I've sent another fax. MS Fax puts this in PENDING status on the outgoing faxes queue.
- 3) When the first fax has finished the second one start the dialing process and then is sent.

This happen always with the other 3 fax devices idle.

My question is: why MS Fax does not send more than 1 fax concurrently ?

The strange thing is that trying the broadcast fax feature, that is providing more than 1 recipients, the faxes are sent concurrently ?

Any hints ?
