I think a more fundamental question is can this UPS run several servers simultaneously to execute a clean shutdown on all of them. It might have been cheaper to buy several smaller units, 1 for each server.

Having said that: Hook the UPS up to one server. In the UPS control properties, have the UPS run a batch script. The batch script should send out a remote shutdown command to each of the other servers. To be honest, I don't remember what the remote shutdown command is -- only that I used to use it to annoy other people in my younger days. It should be easy to find, though.
