I'd use DHCP. Even with so few clients, it's a lot easier to control changes & configuration from a central location. If you have salespeople who use laptops, it's a lot easier for them too – they don't have to manually reconfigure anything (note also that changing IP addresses requires local admin rights, which are a whole nother kettle of fish!)
