Run regedt32, then from the Local Machine Hive, choose Registry|Load Hive. Then navigate to the location of the hive you want to edit/read. Give it some tempname (doesn't matter what). Then when your done, move the cursor back to tempname, then Registry|Unload Hive, Registry|Exit
