Start, settings, control panel, system. Click on the advanced tab and select "Performance Options". Click "Change" by the Virtual Memory label.

Select the second drive and create a page file there of the recommended size and click the "Set" button, then select your "C" drive and set the page file to initial = 0 and Maximum = 0, click the "Set" button again..

You'll have to reboot after you do this.
