I'm trying to run a .bat file which will automatically re-enable a disabled

Windows spooler service and then restart the service. I've got the following

script ready

```
sc config spooler start= auto
net start spooler
```

When the Windows spooler service changes to disabled, i tried putting this script under the recovery option in the services console – (when service fails, run this script), but it does not run... i've tried running the bat file manually and the service is correctly restarted, etc, i just need to find out how to get it to run automatically when the service sets itself

to

disabled.

I think you have the wrong idea. A disabled service is not the same as a failed service, hence your script will never be triggered!

What makes you think that the service sets itself to "disabled"?
