Is there a partition-size limit for USB drives?

I have a USB drive with a 250G HD. I was able to create a single partition using the whole drive space but could not format it (NTFS). When I created two, roughly equal, partitions I was able to format both.

I have not tried that as I am a partition Jockey – however I am sure that I would not format it using USB rather than that I should put it into my computer and format it there. I use 320GB as USB Drives
