User Configuration\AdministrativeTemplates\Desktop\
Hide all icons on Desktop

You may want to take use of Mandatory Profiles to prevent users from do any changes at all to there profile.

If you just want to lockdown the desktop and prevent users from creating item on the desktop you have to modify ACL and prevent users from access the Desktop Folder in there profile, may by redirect the Desktop out side the profile with Folder Redirection within a Group Policy.
