I have a Windows 2000 server network and I'm locking down the Win 2K and XP workstations successfully. I can prevent the users from changing their desktops and screensavers by using a GPO. However, if they go to any websites that offer an option to change their desktops they are able to execute the links and make the change that way. I also have applied a GPO that prevents Windows installer from running and it prevents setup.exe or install.exe from running. But I haven't found a way to prevent an internet link or download from changing the desktop or screen saver. How can I stop this???

Also, for MS Office 2k or above, is there a way to position the shortcut bar and lock it into that position to prevent the user from dragging it to another side or changing it?
