I gather from your brief description that you are using roaming profiles and you have set the policy to exclude files from roaming profiles. It actually seems quite strange to me that the policy is not working, as these particular folders are excluded by default, even if you don't enable this particular policy. I suggest that you check which are the folders being moved: my documents and desktop are by default included in the roaming profile if you don't redirect them, which is the best choice when using this kind of setup. Also, if you don't need it, make sure you disable offline files, which you can also do by policy.
