By default the Domain Controller Security Policy applies only to computers in the domain controller container which should be only domain controllers. Either you have your computers in the domain controllers container or you have the default domain controller GPO linked to the domain container which you can check in AD Users and Computers. Select the domain container/properties/Group Policy to view what GPO's are linked to the domain. You can also use the gpresult free support tool to view what Group Policy's are applied to a computer and the logged on user. — Steve
