Does this happen from the same client computer? When you run gpresult on the TS server while logged on locally at the TS console for each user – one that works and one that does not, does it show they exist in the same Active Directory Container and they have the same group membership? Are there any errors in Event Viewer for that domain controller that may be pertinent?. I would also run first netdiag and then dcdiag on that domain controller looking for any failed tests, errors, warnings, that may indicate a problem with configuration. --- Steve
