Hello TomR,

Your problem does not really belong to the GPO itself. There are a lot of possibilities for this error. First i would check that all services are running, that are set to Automatic. For AD there should run DNS server, Master browser, Distributed File System, File replication service, Kerberos Key Distribution Center, RPC, RPC Locator, Network connections. Windows time service, workstation service. Then check your DNS configuration, in a single domain all servers and clients should only point to the local DNS server from your domain and if you go to internet, your DNS server should have configured a forwarder.
