2 Computers

Both are connected to each other using router SMC 7004ABR.

Same subnet mask/workgroup

PC (1) cannot ping PC (2), but PC (2) can ping PC (1).

> *From PC (1), both computer appears at the same workgroup,*

Attempt to browse PC (2) give a "network path was not found" error.

> *From PC (2), only PC (2) appears at the workgroup,*
