> *the domain they have permissions and no problems.*

> *shares. They can see the domain + W2K server in 'Microsoft Widonws*
> *Network' in windows explorer however don't have permission to view*
> *the shares. When I click the shared directory, a popu box asks for*
> *username + password, but I'm logged into the domain as Administrator*
> *and have max possible rights.*
