>(1) Windows 2000 Server (SP4) (Active Directory)
>(2) 4 Windows 2000 Pro (SP4) joined to the domain
>(1) 5-port switch
>(1) 5-port Linksys router & a DSL Modem
>
>Internet access is blocked on 2 of the clients. I'm blocking them by putting
>their IP address into the security option of the Router & setting
>reservations in DHCP to always use those IPs.
>
>How can I allow email access using MS Outlook but still block internet
>browsing?

Use a proxy server, or an internal mail server. Simple IP configuration can't handle this scenario. There are other ways to block or monitor surfing, you may want to investigate alternatives.
