I have a 2000 pro workstation that shares a Xerox network printer, I have a 7 Windows 2000 Pro workstations and 1 xp-home that works fine but one xp-home is trying to use the shared printer, \\system\xerox , the 2000 Pro workstation has the xp as a user and password.
