How to setup Windows IPsec client

To setup windows IPsec client on w2k/xp, run MMC to add IPsec Security Policies. Right-click on it to create a new IP filter. Make sure both server and client have the same settings such as IP subnet, tunnel IP, pre-shared key and authentication methods.
