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Is there a way to force a RAS client to dicsonnect using a command line (batch)?

I have a network monitor running that test a number of system services, server, functions, etc. This monitor is capable of firing a command line or batch if it detects that a function, server, etc., has "failed". In this case we are monitoring a remote function over a VPN RAS and it periodically fails to respond. However if we disconnect the RAS it will dial in again by itself and we can monitor it again.

So I'm looking for a way to force the dicsonnect when we detect it isn't responding and thus force it to redial and reestablish the connection.
