I think I did it. I finally figured out it was in the registry and that HKLM meant the registry local machine keys. I followed the registry entries down to HKLM\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run and found the entry. I simply deleted it and the command stopped executing. Is this the way to accomplish this task?
