> *I have also checked that*

> *HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\Advanced*

> *SeparateProcess is set to 0, and I have created "DesktopProcess" in*

> *HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer and set*

> *it to 0. The same obnoxious folder keeps popping up at startup.*

Check /maybe/ also HKLM keys:

HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\Advanced  
and

HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer

for the same values. Check registry key

HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\Advanced  
for dword value "PersistBrowsers" – it should be set to 0.

> *Btw – in*

> *HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer there*

> *is a string with the name "Vodka Lime 1" and the value 1744. What is that?*

I don't know – AFAIK this is not a "standard key".

> *Can I remove it?*

Make a backup of HKCU\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer  
and delete that value.
