Thanks for the tips. I created an ERD and told it to save the registry.
I did not see any errors, but I don't recall how to tell if the registry was backed up.

The only reason I was using REGEDT32 was to identify the key that other tools are having trouble with. They all have trouble with the 8th one – the SOFTWARE key.

ERUNT had trouble as well. The main dialog / progress box showed that it was
